Nacoa Privacy Policy

1. What information we record?

HELPLINE

Nacoa receives some personal information given by helpline users. The information is not shared outside Nacoa and no identifying information is recorded on our Helpline Calls Database. We do not ask for personal information and paper copies record no identifying information.

We do not solicit calls, use other agencies' mailing lists or share any information outside Nacoa, other than when we have a statutory obligation to do so. Please see our Confidentiality and Safeguarding Policies.

We also receive personal information (name, address, telephone and email) from callers and professionals through the helpline. We do not solicit or use other agencies' mailing lists or share information outside of Nacoa. The information is used to respond to requests for information and to send information packs only.

GOVERNANCE

Nacoa records personal information (name, address, telephone and email) for Nacoa personnel, including Patrons, Ambassadors, Trustees, Consultative Council Members, Staff and Members in pursuance of good governance. We record the same for suppliers and agencies, i.e. telephone providers, bank, accountants, 12Pay etc. The information is not shared outside of Nacoa and is used only for the purpose it was given.

VOLUNTEERS

Nacoa records personal information (name, address, telephone and email) received from people who wish to volunteer in the pursuance of Nacoa's aims. This information is not shared outside Nacoa and is used only for the purpose it was given.

When processing requests for help for our media, speaker and research panels, we will forward the information provided with contact details for volunteers to pursue. We never share personal information with anyone or any organisation outside Nacoa.

CHARITABLE ACTIVITIES

Nacoa records personal information (name, address, telephone and email) for donors, funders, In memoriam donations, and sponsored eventers in pursuance of funding our helpline services.

This information is not shared outside Nacoa and is used only for the purpose it was given, to thank all donors and to send an Annual Report for the year funds were received.

Likewise, Nacoa records personal information (name, address, telephone and email) for media contacts in pursuance of raising awareness of our aims and helpline services. The information is not shared outside Nacoa and is used only for the purpose it was given, to respond to media requests.

We do not use cookies on our website and only record personal information given by individuals direct.

3. When we can use your information?

We collect and use the personal information given by you in the pursuance of Nacoa's aims outlined above. When personal information pertains to volunteering, we will only contact you regarding the specific areas of volunteering which you checked on the Volunteering Application Form.

We would like to extend invitations to events like the Stafford Ward Memorial Lecture, Volunteers Awards Evening, Upfest and other events. Our events are free of charge and are opportunities to get together and to plan for the future.

4. The period for which we will keep your information

We will keep your information for as long as necessary for us to fulfil Nacoa's aims and for the purposes we describe in this policy. As a general rule, however, we will keep the information until you ask us to remove your details.

You have the right to see the information whenever you wish.

5. Who will we share your information with?

We do not share your information outside Nacoa. When processing requests for help from our media, speaker and research panels, we will forward the enquiry information with contact details for you to pursue. We never give out personal information to anyone or any organisation outside Nacoa.
